NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT at the Governing Board Meeting of March 24, 2023 the Governing Board for the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) will hold a Public Hearing at 9:30 A.M. to receive public input on the SFRTA's intent to apply for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2021 Section 5307 (CFDA 20.507) funds appropriated under the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021, from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).
